YEAR 9 VISIT TO NORTHWOOD HOLOCAUST MEMORIAL DAY EVENTS 2017

Students from our school and others in the area have been invited to attend a 2½ hour workshop to commemorate Holocaust Memorial Day. Holocaust education is part of the national curriculum and is taught as part of History and Religious Education.

Students will have the opportunity to hear the personal testimony of a Holocaust Survivor and, with the guidance of a trained Facilitator, take part in a workshop that will offer students the opportunity to understand some historical facts about the Holocaust and other genocides. They will be able to discuss personal responsibility and how some are still discriminated against today.

The session takes place within school hours. Students will be accompanied by school staff and taken by coach to and from the venue. The trip will cost £5.00 per student and we would like the whole of Year 9 to attend.
