

MFL subject Area at Kings Langley School

The MFL subject area together with the English subject area, make up the Communications Learning Area at the school. MFL team is made up of three full-time and one part-time members of staff.

MFL is a supportive subject area where students are motivated and behaviour is outstanding. All teaching rooms are suited together in our brand new building and are equipped with Clever Touch boards which have access to a range of online resources. For KS3 we use Mira for Spanish and Allez for French. This is also supported by Kerboodle digital resources.

For KS4, we have renewed our resources for both French and Spanish in preparation for the new GCSE specifications and we are using AQA GCSE and Kerboodle digital resources.

At Kings Langley students at KS3 study either French or Spanish, continuing the single language into GCSE if they choose. Take up of GCSE languages is good and AS in both French and Spanish are also being taught.

At the moment students follow the Edexcel exam board for all 3 courses. GCSE Written and Spoken assessments are worth 30% of the course respectively and these are completed internally within the school throughout KS4. Students then sit the Reading and Listening examinations in the summer term and these are worth 20% of the total grade respectively.
