Dear Parent/Carer,

I have great pleasure in announcing a forthcoming Drama workshop at school for GCSE and A level students. They will be working with two performers from 'The Hiccup Project', who will be performing at The Old Town Theatre.

The students will be taking part in a physical theatre workshop which will enable them to gain more knowledge and understanding of different types of theatre styles and genres. The workshop will take place on the 14th March in school from 3.30pm-5.30pm and will be run by the professionals as mentioned above and facilitated by myself. We are very lucky to have this opportunity and I know that your child will find this experience very beneficial.

Students should come prepared to work hard as we will be taking part in physical theatre so they should bring loose comfortable clothing to change into. They should also bring refreshments as it may well become hot in the drama studio and students will need to stay hydrated.

In addition to the above workshop, we are also taking the students to see the live performance of 'It's Ok I'm dealing with this' by the above mentioned company at The Old Town Theatre, Hemel Hempstead on Tuesday 21st March at 8pm, as a way of rounding up the experience.

The workshop will be taking place in school and therefore students should be collected from school at 5.30pm on Tuesday 14th March. On Tuesday 21st March students should meet at the Old Town Hall in Hemel Hempstead no later than 7.40pm as the performance begins at 8pm. It will last approximately 1 hour and therefore parents should ensure that students are picked up promptly from the theatre after the show. Please make sure these details are noted down on the consent form attached and in the event of this changing please inform me immediately.

The combined cost of workshop and the performance will be £18.50 and this will include the cost of the workshop, the performance and insurance whilst at the theatre. (If you child is unable to attend the performance they may still participate in the workshop on the 14th at a reduced cost of £6.00) This should be paid online as soon as possible to secure your place. I would ask you to indicate on the consent form whether you would like your daughter to see both the show and participate in the workshop experience.
