Re: 'Rambert Dance Company' Trip, Sadler's Wells Theatre, London

As part of the GCSE Dance and Performing Arts examinations, the students are required to study a professional dance. To this end I have organised a trip to see 'Rambert Dance Company' at Sadler's Wells Theatre, London on **Tuesday 8th November 2016**.

This performance promises to be an inspiring show that students will gain a vast knowledge and understanding of the professionalism involved in dance at this level as well as understand the craft of choreography and staging.

The students should leave school at the end of the school day as normal and should return to school no later than 5.15pm when the coach will depart for the theatre with the performance to begin at 7.30pm. There is a pre-show discussion led by the choreographers and dancers that will begin at 6.30pm which we are aiming to attend.

The coach will arrive back to Kings Langley School at approximately 11.00pm and parents/guardians should ensure that adequate travel arrangements are made to ensure their son/daughter travels home safely.

The total cost for the ticket, coach and insurance will be **£25.00 per student**. It is in your son/daughter's interest to take advantage of this necessary trip, to ensure that they have fulfilled course requirements for the examinations. As we need to book and pay the theatre for the tickets by 17th October 2016 we do on this occasion need a swift reply from students. The students will not be required to wear school uniform, but we remind you that they are representatives of the school and should dress accordingly.
