

SIXTH FORM DRESS CODE

Sixth form students act as role models for younger students within the school and as such are expected to dress in a manner that expresses personality but also shows dignity, appropriate modesty and respect for fellow members of the school community.

Within this context, Sixth Form students should wear;

Girls	Boys
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Smart trousers• Blouses, shirts• Reasonable length skirts – students should ensure they are able to maintain adequate modesty when arising from a seated position or when navigating stairs.• Jackets• Dresses that have straps wide enough to cover a bra strap.• $\frac{3}{4}$ length smart trousers• Enclosed footwear	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Smart trousers• Chino style trousers• Shirts with buttons and collars• Polo shirts will be allowed after May half term providing they have a collar and buttons.• Suit or casual sports jackets• Jumpers without logo's• Enclosed footwear

Piercings

Only two piercings per ear

One small nose stud is permitted.

NO other facial piercings are allowed.

Students will be asked to remove any other visible piercings. Arguments that piercings will close will not be accepted.

Hairstyles

Should be sensible and suitable for the school environment.

No hair colouring other than a natural colour will be acceptable.

Jewellery and make up

Should also be modest and appropriate for the working environment within school.

Students not complying with the dress code will be spoken to and asked to come in suitably dressed the following day.

Failure to continue to comply with the dress code will eventually result in students being sent home to change.
