The majority of our students are dressed appropriately and we would like to thank them and their parents for supporting this policy. However, we would like to remind all our 6th Form students of the dress code for school.

Sixth Form Dress Code

The sixth form dress code has been agreed in a consultation between a representative group of students and the Headteacher. Sixth Form students act as role models for younger students within the school and as such are expected to dress in a manner that expresses personal dignity and appropriate modesty. **School is a place of work and students are expected to dress smartly.** This does not mean students cannot express individuality through clothing, rather it means sticking to a few basic rules. **Students unacceptably dressed will be sent home – this means no hoodies or jeans.**

Below is a summary of what is permitted within the dress code.

Piercings Only two piercings per ear and one small nose stud. NO other facial piercings are allowed and students will be asked to remove them. Arguments that piercings will close will not be accepted. Students who are unable or unwilling to remove additional piercings will be sent home.	
Hairstyles Should be sensible and suitable for the school environment. No hair colouring other than a natural colour will be acceptable.	
ID Badges Students should also be wearing their ID badges at all times, this enables us to identify KLS 6 th Form students who are authorised to be in the school building. Students should scan in and out at all times for fire regulation procedures and child protection issues.
