

Useful information – School Buses 2008-2009

Watford/Abbots Langley/Garston/Bedmond/Leavesden

- The Hertfordshire SaverCard is available to download from the Kings Langley School website (or from the school office):

- Your child must be age 11-18 and in full time education to be eligible to apply for the SaverCard.
- The SaverCard entitles your child to half price bus fare on ALL buses in Hertfordshire, not just school buses.
- If your child does not have a SaverCard they will be charged the full adult fare.
- **Please apply for the SaverCard as soon as possible as there is often a backlog near the beginning of September. It is not advisable to leave the application until the school holidays unless your child reaches the age of 11 during that time.**
- All other information you will need regarding school buses is also on the Kings Langley School website, including bus routes and bus operator telephone numbers.
- Kings Langley School is not responsible for bus route, fares or the general operation of buses. If you have any question or queries regarding these buses please contact the relevant bus operator or Herts County Council Passenger Transport Unit on 01992 556765.
- Please ensure that your child fully understands the Code of Conduct on school buses. Any questions regarding behaviour on the school buses should be directed to the school.
