Dear Students and Parents

GCSE Geography Field Study – Summer Term 2017

We have arranged residential field work for Year 10 Geography students during the summer term 2017. This field study forms the basis for the exam paper on skills and field study.

We will be staying at Fairhaven Hotel in Weymouth where we have comfortable accommodation including breakfast, evening meal and packed lunch. We have used this hotel for the last four years and they make us most welcome. The hotel has a warm, friendly and secure atmosphere. The hotel also has good 'classroom' facilities which we will be using in the evenings. The field study will be intensive and provides the students with excellent material with which to develop high quality work. Dorset offers great opportunities for coastal studies and investigations in tourism, economic development and ecosystems.

The itinerary for our study will be as follows:

Sunday 9th of July - Olympic Park

9.00am - Coach leaves school and arrives at Weymouth circa 4.00pm.

Monday 10th of July – Coastal Management

Study of the Jurassic coast, including: Lulworth Cove, Durdle Door and Stair Hole.

Tuesday 11th of July – Coastal Landforms

Study of Portland, Chesil and West Bay/Bridport.

Wednesday 12th of July – Bournemouth Urban Study

In the morning students will study the east Dorset coast at Swanage. In the afternoon we return to Kings Langley School. We estimate arriving back at Kings Langley School at 5.00pm.

We have fifty seven students studying Geography in year 10. I hope that all of them are able to join us in this study of the Dorset Coast. The cost for the trip will be £195 per student and includes hotel accommodation, food and coach travel. If you are happy for your son/daughter to take part in the Weymouth Field Study, please complete the reply slip and return to the Finance office with a deposit of £50.00 (online payment) by the 10th February 2017. The balance can then be paid online in two further instalments: £90.00 by 24th of March 2017 and £55.00 by 31st of May 2017

On Wednesday 28th June there will be a meeting in school for students and parents in respect of this trip. The meeting, which will take place in the main hall, will start at 7.30pm and last about 30 minutes. All students on the Weymouth trip are expected to attend this meeting with a parent or carer.
