### **Year 13 – Examination arrangements and summer term diary dates**

As we rapidly approach the end of your time at Kings Langley School and the A Level exams, we wanted to make you aware of the following key dates;

#### **Friday 19<sup>th</sup> May – Governor's Reception and Prom**

The evening will start at 6.00pm with the Governor's reception in the school hall. Followed by dinner/dance at The Noke Hotel, St Albans at 7.30pm

#### **Friday 26<sup>th</sup> May - Last day for year 13 students**

You are expected to be in **all lessons up to and including Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> May** unless you have an exam. Anyone who is resitting AS modules and requires time off to revise must discuss this with the Sixth Form team and get their agreement in advance. Students will meet Sixth Form staff at Kings Langley Cricket Club at 11am for brunch and presentations on Friday 26<sup>th</sup> May.

#### **From Monday 5<sup>th</sup> June onwards**

You should attend school for revision lessons and exams. Revision lessons will take place during normal lesson periods and in the usual rooms until you have completed your exams in that subject.

When in school, you must sign in at the Sixth Form Office (and sign out when you leave). This is important so that we have a record of who is in school at any given time. Normal dress code applies during the exam period – anyone who is dressed inappropriately may be denied access to the Exam Hall.

Once you have completed all of your exams, you will need to return any text books or equipment to school and you must complete and hand in your Book Return form. These forms have already been distributed and need to be completed and returned before your last day in school.
