Re: Mini Enterprise

The aim of Enterprise Education is for students to learn and develop new skills to help them succeed during their working life.

This term we will be introducing 'Enterprise Education' to the Year Nine students by running a 'Mini Enterprise' project. This project will form part of their entitlement, and is designed to fit within their PSHE programme.

Students will be asked to put together plans to make or develop a product or service using only recycled materials or items that can be remanufactured. They will eventually be offering these for 'sale' to the rest of the school during lunchtime on **Wednesday 14 December 2016.**

The students are going to be completing a wide range of tasks in order to fulfil the criteria outlined for Enterprise Education, including, product design, producing a business plan, managing finances, risk taking and presentation skills.

As with any 'Enterprise' project the intention is that every group has the potential to make a profit, and they are encouraged to give a percentage of any profit made to a charity of their choice, with the remainder being shared between their group. However, there is also the risk of a group not making anything at all, although this is also very much part of the overall learning process!

We hope the students enjoy this programme and enter into the spirit of the occasion.
