#### **Important Information**

### Booking Opening and Deadline: The booking window opens on Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> October 2024 at 10:00am and closes on Monday, 2nd December 2024 at 10:00am.

- Deposits
  - <u>Non-refundable deposits</u> are required by the deadline (Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2024) for Phasels
    Wood (£45 deposit) and ESSA Water Activity Centre (£35 deposit) to secure spots on these trips.
  - All other trips require **full payment** to secure a pupil's place.
  - Failure to pay the deposit or full amount before **Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2024** will result in the loss of the student's place. This place will then be offered to another student.
  - All trips are <u>number dependent</u>. If a trip is cancelled due to lack of interest, all deposits will be returned.
- **Costs and Limited Places:** Costs apply to trips and workshops, with places available on a first-come, first-served basis.
- **Financial Assistance/Pupil Premium:** We have reserved spaces on all trips and activities for students who are entitled to Pupil Premium and/or financial support. If you are entitled to Pupil Premium/financial support, please email to the Activities email address above with your preference for trips. We will do our best to meet all requests.
- **Trip Booking Process:** Parents need to log into ScoPay (<u>https://www.scopay.com/login</u>) to reserve places and make the required deposit payments. Only trips available to your child will be shown on your ScoPay account.
- **Residential Trips:** PGL Shropshire, Phasels Wood, Lyon and Seville trips require additional physical consent, along with medical and emergency contact information. You will be contacted when your place has been secured and the process of collecting information has started.
- Year Group-specific trips: Please note that each trip is for a designated year group. If students do not wish to participate in any activities specified above, then alternative activities <u>at school</u> will be offered, free of charge. There are limited places available for trips detailed above and we offer <u>places first come, first</u> <u>served</u>.

### Phasels Wood (Thursday 17th – Friday 18th July)

The cost of the trip is **£90** with a **non-refundable deposit of £45 to be paid by Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2024**. The final payment of £45 will need to be paid by 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2025. The cost of the trip includes venue hire, food and insurance. They will only need a small amount of spending money.

Phasels Wood, near Kings Langley, is a 95-acre outdoor activity centre and campsite. The Year 7 group will camp for 1 day at Phasels Wood and walk to and from the site from school. They'll enjoy a range of outdoor activities, such as zip-lining, climbing, and archery, perfect for a short adventure away from home.
