

Caius 9&10 Programme

Application deadline: Midday on Friday 21 March 2025

The program will consist of a series of **online** after-school sessions. The students will receive both guidance and ideas on how to explore subject interests, and an introduction to studying at University. Students will also have the chance to talk to current Cambridge students and attend an online lecture.

Session 1, Wed 23 April 2025, 4:30-5:30pm:	Introduction to studying at university and Oxbridge
Session 2, Wed 7 May 2025, 4:30-5:30pm:	Exploring subject interests
Session 3, W/C 19 May 2025, 5:00-6:00pm:	Taster lectures (one STEM lecture, one humanities)
Session 4, Wed 11 June 2025, 4:30-5:30:	Student Life Q&A (life at university, clubs, societies)
Session 5, Wed 18 June 2025, 4:30-5:30:	Session chosen by students

Given the time of year, I'd recommend a talk on student finance and managing money for your year 13 students. For your year 12 students, our sessions on the UCAS process and choosing a course and university would be helpful as they start to plan their next steps.

Study in the North Webinar:

We are also collaborating on a webinar with staff and students from the Universities of Lancaster, Sunderland and Newcastle. The webinar is designed for students who are in the early stages of their university research and are considering relocating for their university study.

The session will introduce the North to those who are less familiar with the region, followed by a quick insight into the respective universities. Most valuably, there will be a Q&A session with current student ambassadors from each of the institutions, where attendees will be encouraged to ask any questions they have about studying in the North and making informed decisions about choosing where to study.
