Re: Revision strategies and Reading Evening

On Thursday 8th December, we are providing an evening on “How to help your child with revision and Reading for their exams”. This will demonstrate activities that could be used to revise and the ways in which they can be supported by parents or other adults. With the greater focus on the examinations; the increased content with the specifications and a reduction in NEA marks, it is even more important that students learn how to learn and recall knowledge. As teachers and parents, it is important we support and work on these methods with our children, so they are to achieve their full potential.

Reading fluently and precisely is a key skill that needs to be practised in order to be used effectively in GCSE exams and beyond. Reading in an exam is a very different skill to reading for pleasure and this evening will take you through strategies that students can adopt in order to become more proficient in this skill.

The evening will begin at 6.30pm and lasts approximately one hour and a quarter. It is designed for adults and students to attend together, so that the ideas and methodology are shared and understood by both parties.
